## Arkansas No Kid Afterschool Meals Grants

The Arkansas No Kid Hungry Campaign, through its national sponsor Share Our Strength, is providing a grant opportunity for Child and Adult Care Food (CACFP) sponsors to help organizations expand access and participation in USDA-supported afterschool meals programs.

Organizations may apply for grants up to \$2,000. Organizations that receive funding must fully align with the No Kid Hungry Campaign's goals: access, education, and awareness. These goals are further outlined on the No Kid Hungry website at: <http://www.nokidhungry.org>. Grant funds are focused on projects with long-term impacts and/or food support infrastructure needs such as kitchen equipment and transportation.

### Requirements:

- Your organization can be a Faith or Community based program and/or 501c3 nonprofit organization in good standing with the IRS.
- If your organization was previously an after-school or summer meal program provider, your program must currently be considered to be in good standing within administrative agency guidelines.
- You must have already started the CACFP application process at the time you submit your grant application, and approval of your **grant** application will be contingent on approval of your CACFP application.

### Instructions:

2. Create an account by filling in the "Step 1 of 2: Account Set-Up" (Please check junk/spam email for confirmation email)
3. Complete "Step 2 of 2: Contact Information"
4. Complete Organizational Information Page
5. You will then be taken to a page where you may input your access code: **ARCACFP2017**. **If you are having trouble accessing the application, PLEASE UPDATE YOUR WEB-BROWSER or use a different web browser than Internet Explorer.**
6. Fill in all required information and submit application.
