SANITATION

1. The food service at all facilities must comply with state and local sanitation laws, regulations and requirements. This includes the acquisition, storage, preparation, transport, delivery, and serving of food. Institutions shall ensure that adequate equipment and resources are available to store and hold food safely.

2. As applicable, facilities must maintain current sanitation permit or satisfactory report current within the past 12 months of an inspection conducted by a local sanitarian or an environmental health authority. Day care homes facilities are exempt from this requirement.
3. Institutions that enter into a Food Service Contract for CACFP meals with a food service vendor must assure that the vendor meets state and local food safety and sanitation regulations. If the vendor is a food service management company, then the company shall have federal, state or local health certification for the plant in which it proposes to prepare food for CACFP meals and it shall insure that the health and sanitation requirements are met at all times.
