RE: Automatic Revocation of Tax- Exempt Status

For Immediate Release:

It has been brought our attention that according to the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) that several sponsor's IRS tax-exempt status has been revoked, and is no longer an IRS designated tax-exempt organization.

This MEMO is a reminder that all non-profits doing business with USDA must have a current and active tax-exempt status with the IRS. Should your IRS tax-exempt status have been revoked or if you are not in good standing with the Arkansas Secretary of State Office, you will not be able to participate in the 2015 SFSP.
