ACDS Processing Module

- Go to AR DHS Information Website
- SY2011 FFV Info/Initial FFV
- Listing of schools entitlement dollars
- \$ in FFV column is dollars to use in FFV
- \$ in PAL column is dollars that will be put in school PAL balance for commodities
 - Orders may be placed in November to use these funds. Complete *Commodity Order Form*.

DOD Fresh Fruit & Vegetable Program SY2011

- Addendums are due into CDO by May 31
 - Form was emailed to Districts 4/2/10
- CDO MUST have up-to-date contact information on every School District
- Form has been revised to remove the listing of non-delivery dates
- **IMPORTANT:** Districts must input non-delivery dates into ACDS by May 31 for the next school year
 - Superintendent will sign addendum
 - This will eliminate the scheduling of deliveries when Districts are not available

Addendums

- If any contact information changes during the school year
 - Complete a new Update/Change Form
- The Commodity Office is responsible for communicating to the School Districts
- Be sure to read and reply to any correspondence from CDO; all information is important!
 - Deadlines. Food Alerts or Recalls.

Communication

- Commodity Agency Invoice-Items requested
- PFG Invoice –list of items delivered
 - Documents SHOULD match
 - Errors must be reported before driver leaves (or you will lose monies)
 - Note short or damaged # of cases
 - School & delivery driver must sign
 - Fax to the Commodity Office

Commodity Deliveries

- The new process of receiving commodities
 - Schools no longer receive commodities unless they place orders this eliminates having unneeded items
 1. School districts request total amount of commodities on Projected Annual Use Report in ACDS
 2. CDO has ordered these products from USDA
 3. Schools are obligated to order the products they have requested

NOTE: If you receive an overage on a delivery, it belongs to another school. Driver must return product to PFG.

Commodity Order Process

- USDA allows states to spend 33% of overall state budget in period 8/15-11/15
- The Commodity Office has ordered \$2.4M in commodities for this period
 - Products ordered are based on the majority vote of the school districts (see pages 12-16 of presentation)
- Remaining commodity inventory will be delivered Nov.30-March.
- School Districts should expect to menu the majority of requested commodities December 2010-April 2011

Commodity Budget

Orders may not exceed 33% of PAL Beginning

Example: Total PAL entitlement \$92,000

33% of \$92k=\$30,360; maximum of orderable commodities in the first part of the year

- To calculate your commodity order
 1. Print out your SY2011 Projected Annual Use Report (in ACDS “Commodity” tab)
 2. Use *Commodity Order Worksheet*; lists the products expected to be available in the first part of year. Calculate order value up to 33%.
 3. Use worksheet data to enter monthly orders.
