

## RACE AND ETHNICITY DATA COLLECTION FORM

In accordance with federal guidance, a two part question must be used to collect data about client's race and ethnicity. The first part of the question is on ethnicity and the second is on race. The race question can have multiple values.

### Race/Ethnicity Two-Part Question:

**Part 1: Ethnicity**    **Is the client Hispanic or Latino? (Choose one)**

- No, not Hispanic or Latino
- Yes, Hispanic or Latino (A person of Mexican, Puerto Rican, Cuban, South or Central American or other Spanish culture or origin, regardless of race.)

**Part 2: Race**    **What is the client's race? (Choose one or more if client is not Hispanic or Latino)**

- American Indian or Alaska Native (A person having origins in any of the original tribal people of North and South America, including Central America and who maintains affiliation or community attachment.)
- Asian (A person having origins in any of the original peoples of the Far East, Southeast Asia, or the Indian subcontinent including, for example, Cambodia, China, India, Japan, Korea, Malaysia, Pakistan, the Philippine Islands, Thailand, and Vietnam.)
- Black or African American (A person having origins in any of the black racial groups of Africa.)
- Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander (A person having origins in any of the original people of Hawaii, Guam, Samoa, or other Pacific Islands.)
- White, (A person having origins in any of the original peoples of Europe, the Middle East, or North Africa.)
